SPECIAL PROVISIONS IN DEVIATION FROM THE EXHIBITOR REGULATIONS (STATUS SEPTEMBER 2020)

In deviation from Paragraph 16.3 of the General Terms and Conditions for Participation in Exhibitions (status September 2020), the final invoice will be issued within three months of the end of the exhibition.

WITHDRAWAL

In deviation from Paragraph 17 of the General Terms and Conditions for Participation in Exhibitions (status September 2020), the lump-sum compensation payable in the event of withdrawal will be calculated in accordance with the following table (Paragraph 17 remains applicable in all other respects).

Time at which notification is received by MCH prior to the official opening day of the exhibition	Compensation in % of the net fee for the ordered*) or agreed exhibition floor space or participation package
≥ 180 days	0%
< 180 days, but ≥ 150 days	25%
< 150 days, but ≥ 120 days	50%
< 120 days	100%

*) in the event of withdrawal before the exhibitor receives confirmation of their stand

In deviation from Paragraph 18.2, Sub-Paragraph 1 of the Exhibitor Regulations (status September 2020), if MCH cancels the exhibition prior to its official opening day for reasons set out in Paragraph 18.1 of the Exhibitor Regulations (status September 2020), the exhibitor will not be obliged to bear a portion of the costs that MCH has incurred up until the time of cancellation. This means that you will receive a full refund of the net fee for the exhibition floor space or for your participation package, insofar as you have made an advance payment for this. At the time of cancellation of the exhibition, MCH and the exhibitor will be released from their respective contractual performance obligations; any claims of the exhibitor against MCH, including in particular but not exclusively claims for damages and the reimbursement of expenditure (such as for stand construction services, hotel accommodation, travel expenses, etc.), already incurred by the exhibitor for their participation in the exhibition, are excluded.

The remaining provisions of Paragraph 18.2 remain applicable unchanged.
